Dear Parents/Carers

Along with this letter you will receive a letter from the **North West London Health Protection Team** and **Public Health**, please do take the time to read them.

I understand that there is a great deal of fear regarding the current situation.

I have spoken at length with advisors from the health protection team and we are following all advised measures. Should we have any further cases (of scarlet fever or chicken pox) the current measures will be reviewed.

It is highly concerning that we are having to send children home within minutes of coming to school because they are so unwell, especially with a very high temperature. I understand that children can become very unwell during the school day but it is not acceptable to send a very poorly child to school, it is not fair on the child and it puts all the other children at risk.

Please ensure you call the school office to advice of any absence. It is vital that you provide us with information regarding why your child is absence as this ensures that we have a complete picture as to what is happening. It is not helpful when we find out about a child's absence from other parents and in delays any necessary action.

If there any updates regarding the situation, you will be informed.
