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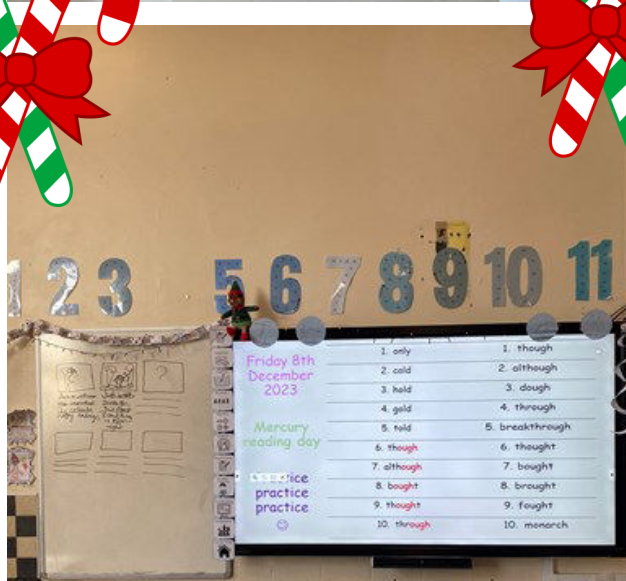


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Friday 8th December 2023—Eddie the Elf!

I wonder where he will be next week? Keep an eye out!



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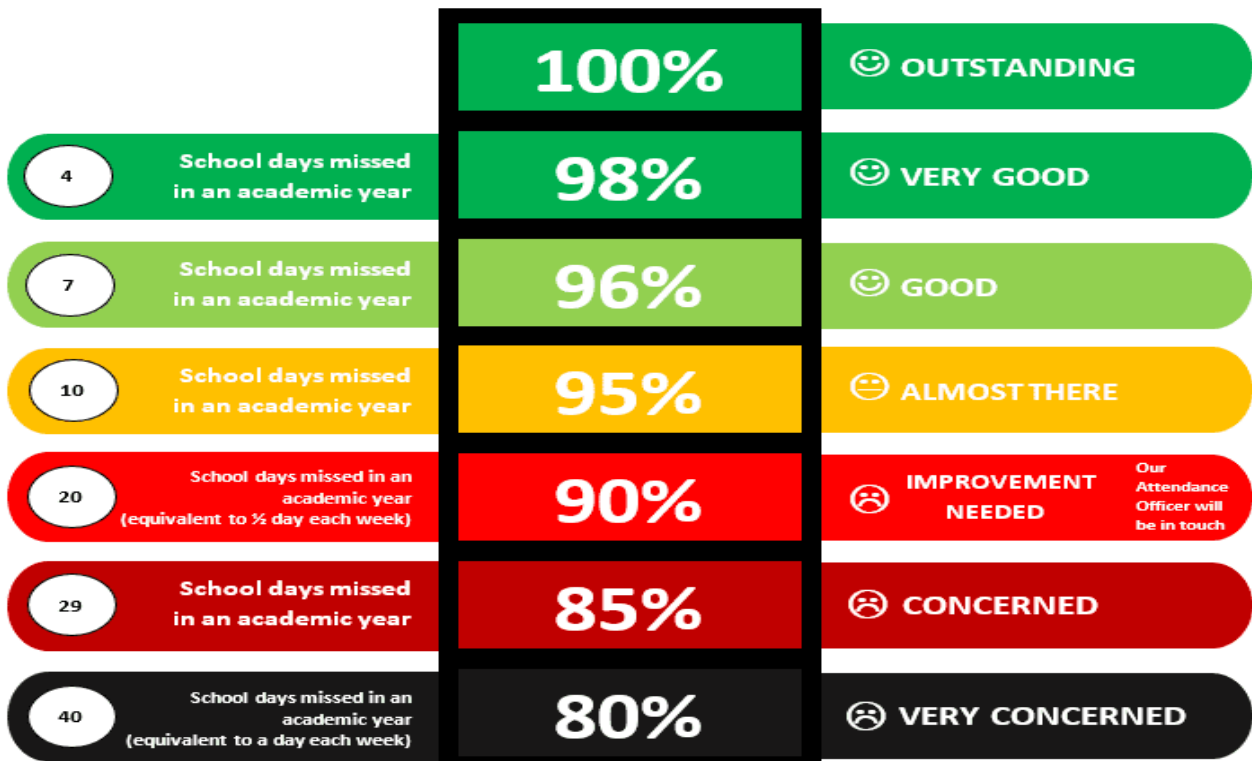
