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Dear Parents and Carers

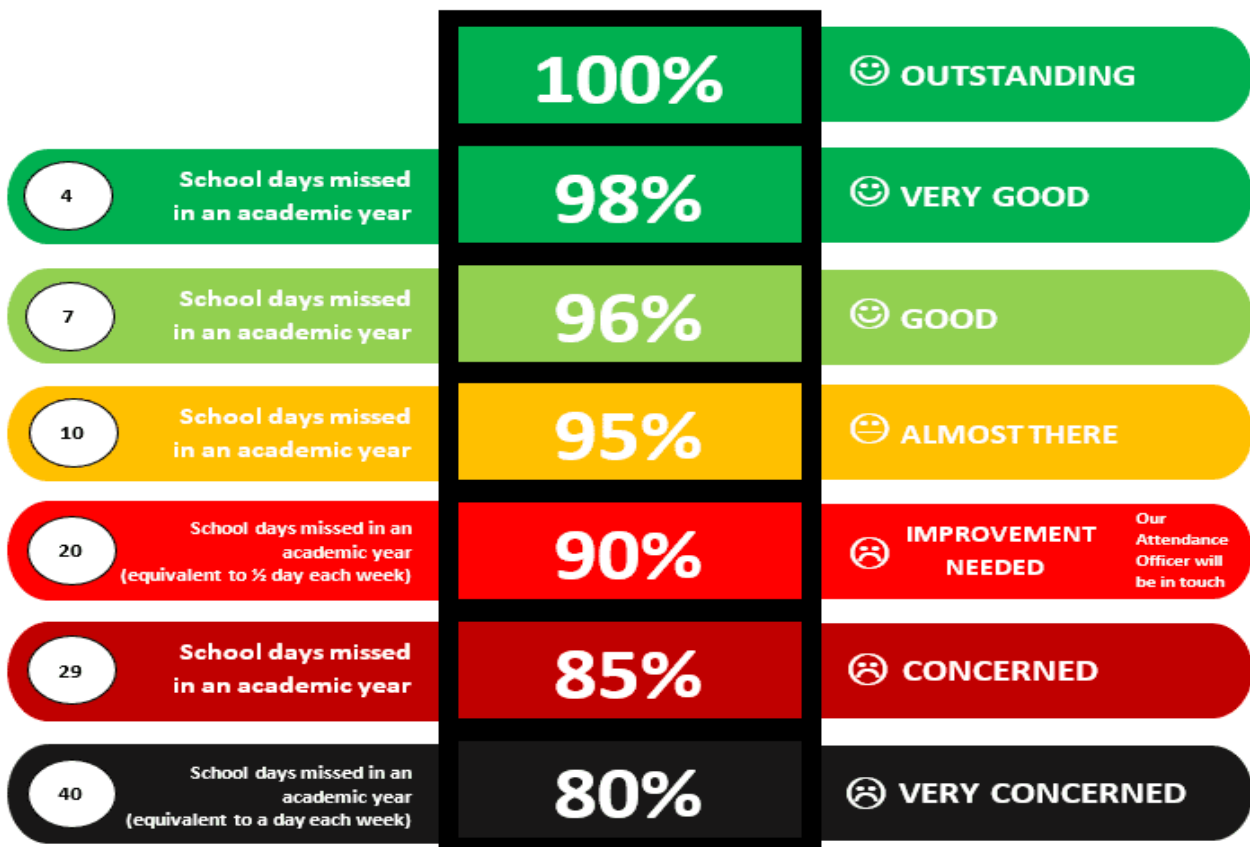
The current whole school attendance figure is 93%. This is not acceptable and is impacting on the progress of the children.
