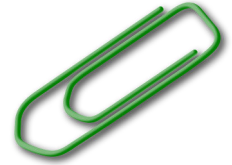


HT Open Door—Parking

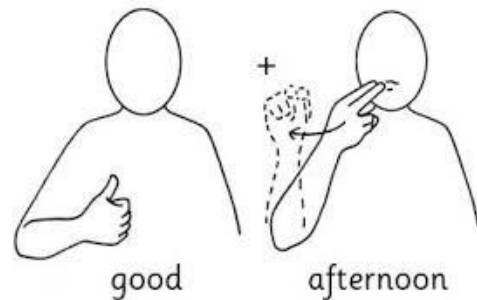
