Some exciting news is that from next week, Ms Lowe will be teaching in 2G. We are very happy that she will take on the class and lead them for the rest of the school year. The children in the rest of the school will still have their art lessons, but taught by another teacher. Ms Lowe will be keeping a close eye on the quality of the lessons as part of her role as art co-ordinator, but it is important to give 2G the stability of a permanent teacher and she will be an amazing support to the children as she knows them all well and they know her.

Our staff training this week was working with St John's staff to see how the PKC curriculum is taught in the Early years (Nursery and Reception) and understanding how the themes/topics and key knowledge are reviewed and built on as the children move through the school to year 6. It was fascinating to see how the topics and themes are revisited and how the children's knowledge of a topic grows as they move through the school.
