Dear Families,

Year 1 went on their school trip to Gunnersbury Museum this week and a very valuable learning experience!

Well done to all the children who competed in the sports day on Tuesday this week. It was a very successful day enjoyed by the children, staff and parents.

Parents, I would like to raise your awareness of the use of social media, gaming and WhatsApp. All of which have age limits, however, many children across the school are using these platforms. The age limit of WhatsApp for example, is 13. Children should not be using WhatsApp, creating their own groups and communicating through WhatsApp whilst they are in Primary school. The groups can create a forum for bullying and social isolation. Please always be vigilant when your child is on a device. You must always know what they are doing, what they are accessing and who they are talking to. If your child is using platforms such as WhatsApp, to safeguard your children, please make sure you are reading the messages that are being sent!

Attendance - This is one of our Ofsted action points. Please help us, please bring your children to school. Only 3 classes this week have attained the 96% or over attendance rate that we expect and has been set by the government. We need good attendance by all the children to help be a 'good' school.

Please can you make sure your child brings their packed lunch to school with them in the morning. Please do not drop your child's packed lunch to the school office during the school day. Thank you for supporting us with this!

The school day begins at 8:45 am and finishes at 3:15pm for all the children which amounts to 32.5 hours per week.

The school gates opens at 8:35. Learning begins at 8:45, all children must be in their classrooms by 8:45. Any child arriving after this time will be marked as late!
