Dear Families,

Thank you to all the parents/carers that attended the parent forum this week. These will be held half termly to inform you of all the updates and progress the school is making. Minutes of this meeting will be posted in the Newsletter section of the school website.

The School Streets pop up event was a success, with many parents and local residents who came along to express their views and opinions on how to make the streets around Drayton Green Primary School safe.

We have had 2 fantastic themed days this week. Year 4 had a Viking day, Mr Davies was .... for the day. Year 3 are having an Ancient Egyptian themed day, we even have our very own Cleopatra in the form of Miss Bakhtiari!

After half term we are going to be working really hard with all families to ensure that all children are in school on time and learning in the classroom starts on time. The school day starts at 8:45, this means that learning in the classroom starts at 8:45. The gates will open at 8:35, which allows your child 10 minutes to get into their classroom and begin their learning, the gates will shut at 8:45. Any child that arrives after 8:45 will be marked as late. We want to make sure that all children at DGPS are maximising all their time in school and that no learning time is lost. We have many children still arriving in school at 8:55 & 9:00. Please work with us and get your children to school on time.

Nursery will not be opening their doors until 8:45 as the 3 hour morning session does not start until 8:45.

Please can we ask that no parents come into the school building in the morning, unless it is the main school reception to register your child as late. If you need to talk to your child's class teacher, this can be done at the end of the school day in the playground. Again, if you talk to your child's class teacher in the mornings, this takes away from learning time.

The only entrance in to the main school building in the morning will be through the lunch hall.

**School is closed next week for the half term break, we reopen on Monday 3rd June.**

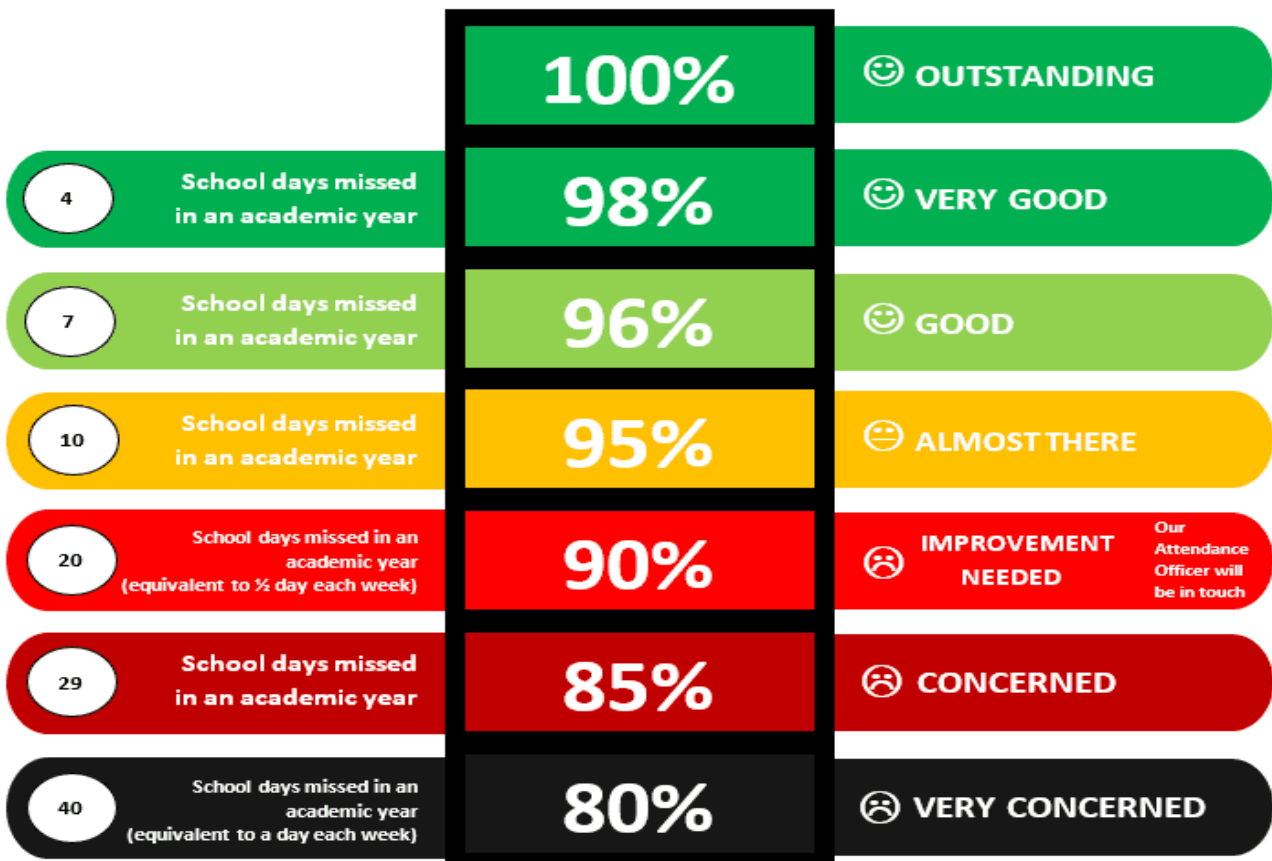
