Well done to all the Year 6 children who have been doing their SATs this week. You have all worked extremely hard and everyone at Drayton Green is very proud of you all!

I am very happy to inform you that Miss Aladag has been appointed as our interim early years leader, she is making great strides in moving the practise and curriculum forwards in early years. She is working very closely with her team in the early years, the early years consultant's in the borough and the senior leadership team in school. A new early years curriculum has been written, that has clear progression for our children from Nursery into Reception and the enabling learning environments within early years are continually developing and moving forwards. 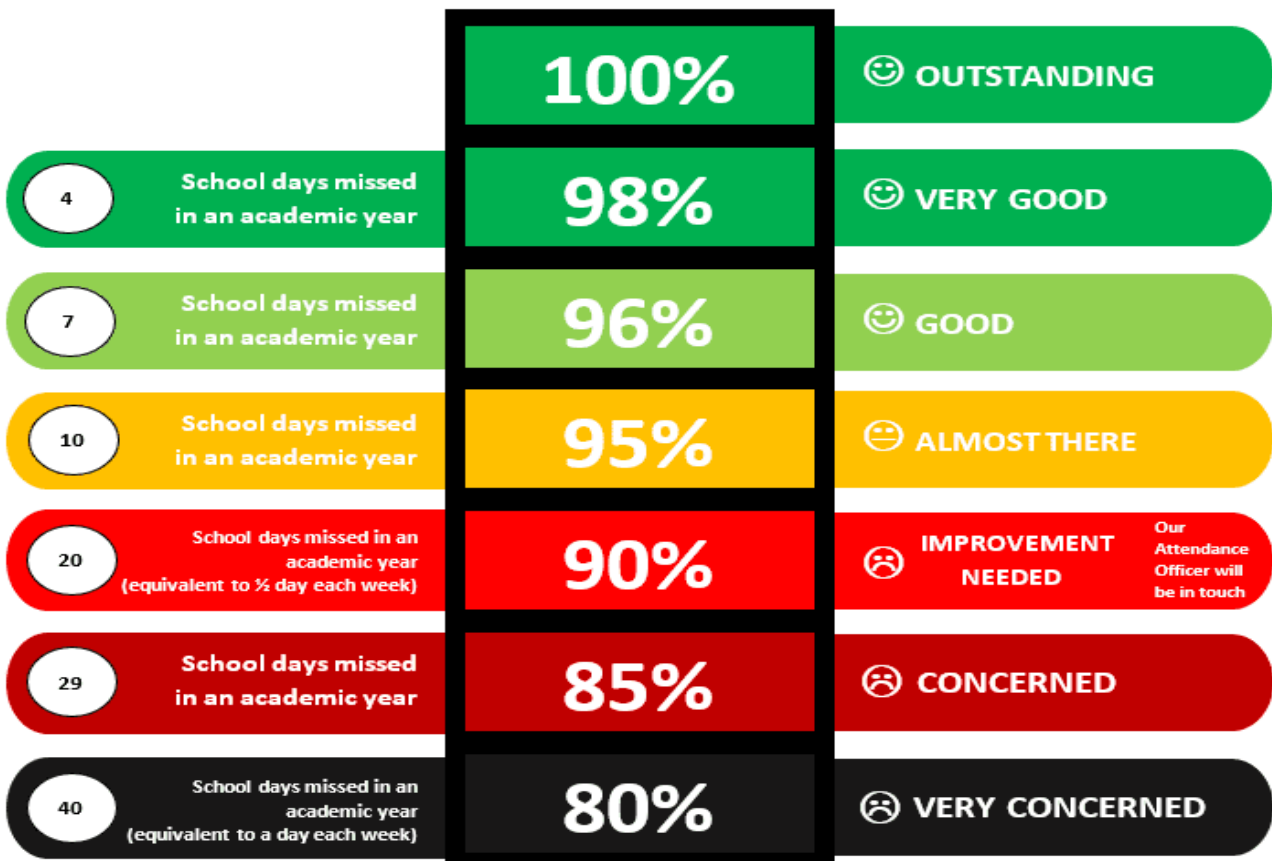
