As you are now aware, attendance is one of our Ofsted action points. We are going to be putting a lot of systems in place to ensure we improve children attendance at Drayton Green, however, we cannot do this alone. Parents, it is your responsibility to ensure that your child is in school everyday they can be. Schools very local to Drayton Green Primary school have much better attendance than us. The children that attend Drayton Green cannot be unwell a lot more than children in other local primary schools. No term time leave will be authorised, while we sympathise that flights are so much cheaper during in term time, it is detrimental to children's education to have time off during term time. The children get 13 weeks holiday a year and this is when you should be taking your holiday. All families wishing to take their child out of school for a holiday during term time will receive a fine from the local authority.

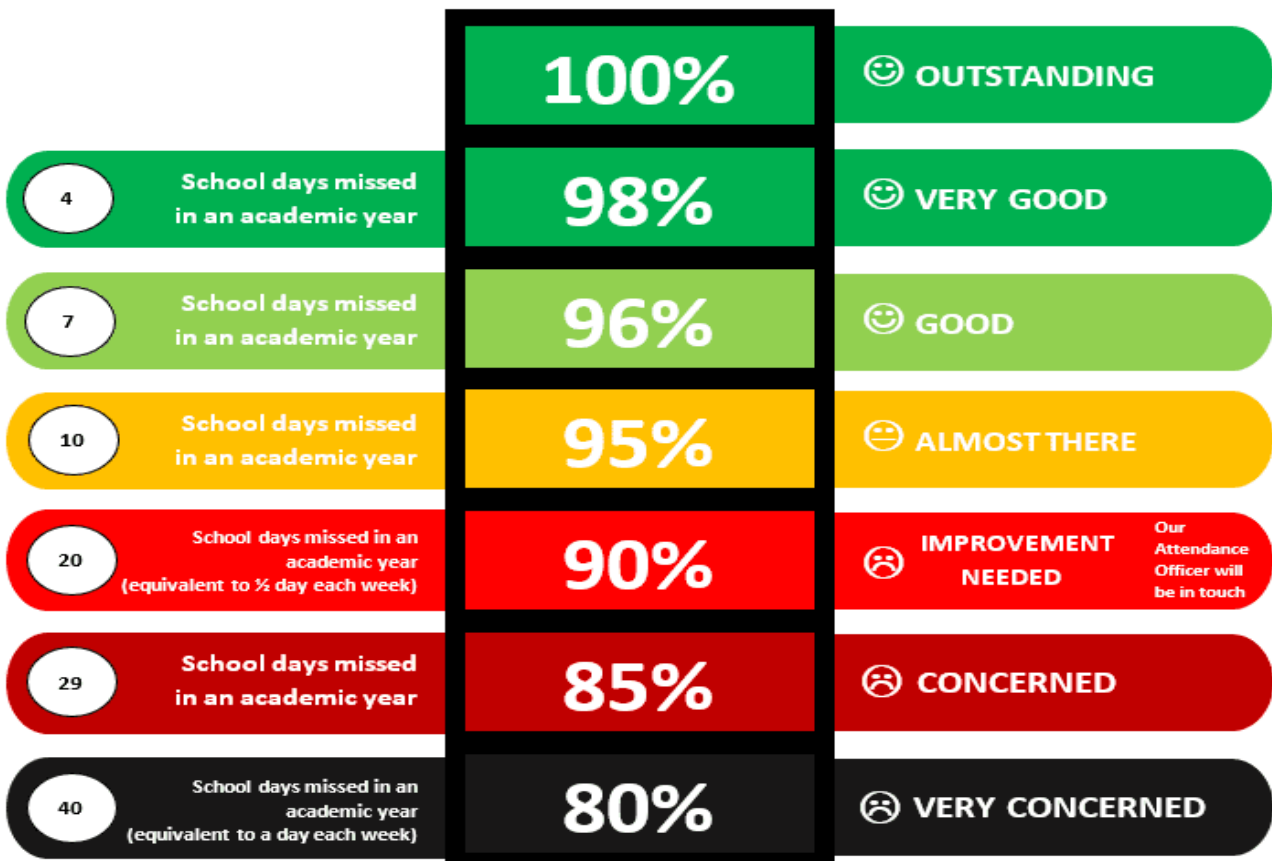
