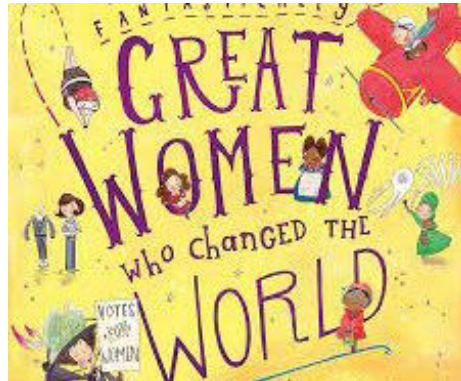
Happy International Women's Day!
