In Reception, we are trying to enhance our outdoor learning environment, but we need your help! We would be grateful if parents and carers can kindly help us and donate any recycled and reclaimed materials, they may have at home so we can use them in our playground.

We need: Large amounts of sand, soil and bark, fake grass, planting seeds, natural plants, planting pots, pebbles, and gardening tools for the garden area

Crates, guttering & pipes, reels, tubes, tyres, stepping stones/logs and tubtrugs, long and short pieces of wood and logs for the construction area

Real kitchen appliances: kettles, toasters, microwaves, radios/tapes, hoovers, mobile phones, hair dryers, desk lamps, laptops etc. Old kitchen or bathroom sinks, pots and pans, colanders, sieves, kitchen utensils, wooden and metal spoons, different sized containers, steel teapots, cupcake and metal trays for the mud kitchen area
