MATHEMATICS

Autumn

Topics:

- Place value to 1,000,000
- Mental addition and subtraction
- Multiplies, factors and prime numbers
- Calculating with fractions
- Roman numerals to 100 (M).

All children must know their multiplication and division facts for up to, and including, the 12 times table.

Throughout the term, children will also participate in frequent Maths Meetings and FlashBacks designed to reinforce fluency skills. Children will use TTRS to rehearse their multiplication facts. They will have regular problem solving activities to build reasoning skills.

HUMANITIES

History

Autumn 1: Bagdad 900CE

In this unit, children learn about the significance of Bagdad in the 10th century

Autumn 2: British Empire

Children will then learn about some of the significant decisions and events that resulted in the birth and expansion of the British Empire.

Geography

Autumn 1: Spatial Sense

In this unit children will look at lines of longitude and latitude as well as the Prime Meridian. They will explore coordinates, map scale and will calculate distance on a map.
