MATHEMATICS

Autumn

- Place Value numbers to 10,000 and rounding
- Addition and Subtraction 4-digit numbers
- Area
- Multiplication and Division 3, 6, 7 and 9 times tables

Throughout the term, children will also participate in daily Maths Meetings and FlashBacks designed to reinforce fluency skills. They will have regular problem solving activities to build reasoning skills.

The children will be tested on their times tables knowledge at the end of year 4. They will be having regular times tables assessments throughout the year.

HUMANITIESHistory

Autumn 1 & 2 - Ancient Greece

Children will study Ancient Greek life, explore their achievements and learn about how they have influenced the western world.

Geography

Autumn 1- Spatial Sense

Children will learn more about the globe and the lines geographers draw around it to help locate places, such as the equator and lines of longitude and latitude.

Autumn 2- Mediterranean Europe

Children will identify the countries surrounding the Mediterranean Sea. They will build on their knowledge of countries, capital cities and flags of the countries in this region.

ENGLISH
