General

- Please read with your child **every day**. Your child will have an individual book which they need to read at home.
- Your child will attend morning phonics lessons and be assessed throughout the year.
- Knowledge Organisers – Students will be sent home with knowledge organisers for key units for this term. Students should review and revise key knowledge from these organisers to ensure the knowledge is being retained in the long-term memory.
- P.E. Kits: Please ensure your child's name is clearly labelled on his/her P.E. kit. We have P.E. on **Thursdays**.
- Homework will be set on **Fridays** and needs to be returned on **Tuesdays**. If your child requires any support with their homework, please ask them to speak with the class teacher on **Mondays**. Please read and review all the spelling words the children bring home. Learning these words is essential for their reading and writing.
- The children will have frequent quizzes throughout the week - please ask them about their scores and progress, and encourage them to revise.

CURRICULUM LEAFLET

MATHEMATICS

Topics:

- Place Value – within 10
- Addition and Subtraction – within 10
- 2D and 3D shapes

We will be introducing daily Mastering Number sessions to reinforce number fluency.

All children need to be familiar with skip counting in 2s, 5s and 10s as well as learn their number bonds to support their maths skills

HUMANITIES

History

Autumn: Romans in Britain

Children will be discovering history. They will think about what we know about the past and develop an awareness of time.

Geography

Autumn: Spatial Sense

Children will learn the concept of aerial views and what physical and human features are.

ENGLISH

Our **key texts** this term are:

Where's my Teddy? and *Peace at Last* in English.

The **children's writing** will focus on:

- Constructing sentences orally before writing
- Use their knowledge of phonemes to sound out words and write them down
- Use capital letters and full stops correctly
- Form all letters correctly
- Retelling familiar stories in the correct sequence.

Our **grammar focuses** will be:

- Children will learn about sentence structure to help them form subject, verb, object sentences.
- Children will learn when to use capital letters and full stops in their writing
- Children will learn to use prepositions, time adverbials and expanded noun phrases.
- Children will learn to identify nouns, adjectives and verbs.

Phonics and Spelling

Children are taught phonics and reading through the Read Write Inc programme. They will be given books containing the phonemes they need to practice. Spelling is taught throughout the week. Children will have weekly spelling lists which they will be tested on. The national curriculum spelling expectations will be stuck into homework books - please practise these with your child as often as possible.

P.E.

The children will be participating in a range of games designed to develop team co-operation as well as attacking and defending strategies lead by our Boom Sports teacher.
