MATHEMATICS

Autumn

- Place value numbers to 1.000
- Addition and subtraction 3-digit numbers
- Multiplication and division 3, 4, 5 and 8 times tables

Daily Maths Meetings to revise other aspects of maths .

All children need to learn their times tables and number bonds at home to support their maths skills.

HUMANITIES

History

Autumn 1 - Stone Age to Iron Age

Children will learn how and why people settle in communities around the world. They will compare and contrast different villages and settlements.

Autumn 2 - Ancient Egypt

Children will explore life and social structure in Ancient Egypt. They will learn about religious beliefs of the Ancient Egyptians and key archaeological discoveries.

FNGLISH

Our **key texts** this term are:

'Into the Forest' by Anthony Brown and a range of familiar fairytales in English. There's a Pharoh in the Bathtub and Ellie and the Cat in Destination Reader

The children's writing will focus on:

- Retelling familiar stories
- Writing a prequel/sequel or alternative version of a fairytale
- We will be focussing on the following features:

- Expanded noun phrases
- Similes and metaphors

Our grammar focuses will be:

- Accurate use of full stops and capital letters, including proper nouns.
- Begin to use a range of punctuation including inverted commas for direct speech ("").
