I am aware that securing a GP appointment is challenging and this can increase worry for parents whilst trying to support a child who is unwell.

Please remember that pharmacists are an excellent source of information and advice. However do not delay if you are very concerned, NHS111 should be your first port of call but if your child needs urgent care and assistance do not hesitate in seeking it.
