Should there be additional communication from the Health protection Team I will share it via class pages.

Please do view the NHS advice regarding scarlet fever, what to look out for and then the action you should take.

The amount of cars that park dangerously is growing. I do not want children to be late but more than that I do not want anyone injured or worse.
