Flu vaccinations

The Flu immunisation team will be coming into school on Monday 20th October to give the children the flu vaccine. This is very important, not just to prevent them from getting sick, but also to prevent them from spreading flu germs to vulnerable relatives or neighbours.

The standard vaccine is a spray in the nose. It is very quick and doesn't hurt or irritate the children. This vaccine has gelatine in it so if you would prefer, your child can have an injection with a different version of the flu vaccine that does not contain gelatine.

Please complete the form that was sent to you and say whether your child will have the vaccine and if you would like them to have the injection rather than the nasal spray.

We will be having a Halloween themed disco on 23rd October after school.

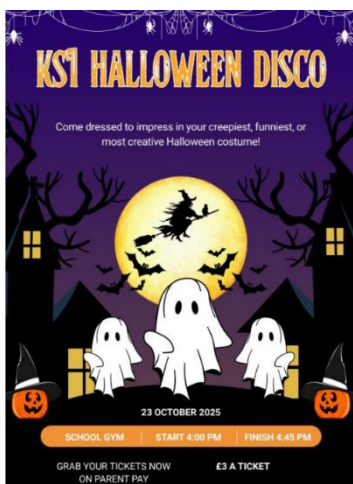
4pm – 4:45pm -for children in Reception, Year 1 and 2
